innovation at Made in Britain debate

British manufacturing association Made in Britain is staging a metals industry panel debate on innovation at the UK Metals Expo. The debate 'Metal Matters: UK Manufacturers Driving Growth through Innovation' will take place at 11am on 14th September at the NEC. Made in Britain has invited key industry experts to share their vision, including Mark Moody, Sales and Marketing Director at UK standard parts and components manufacturer and supplier, WDS Components Ltd.

The debate will explore UK metal industry innovation in materials, supply chain, and product design. The panel is also set to discuss industry challenges including rising steel prices and a reduction in global supply. This is an area where UK manufacturers can have an advantage.

Manufacturing innovation at WDS' Yorkshire plant has included recent expansion with three additional CNC machines, to increase capacity and improve quality. This has also coincided with increased recruitment, particularly for new technical expertise in support of WDS' established

skilled engineers. This has raised the quality and productivity of standard parts and components, which has also increased availability.

"We're experiencing growing demand and, as a result of our continuous innovation, we have increased stock holding and reduced lead times to meet these requirements. We have new products coming into our range each and every week. This confidence is demonstrated through our Stock Guarantee offer that gives 10% discount off the order value if a quantity of products cannot be fulfilled by the initial order," says Mark.

"The Stock Guarantee programme, combined with additional planning arrangements, works particularly well for OEMs, but it also provides confidence in supply to every customer. We try to establish closer working relationships with the high volume OEMs because it increases the efficiency of supply and improves the time to market for the development of their products," adds Mark.

WDS has designed and manufactured standard parts and components in Yorkshire for over 70 years, supplying customers around the world. The company has been a member of Made in Britain since 2014. The Made in Britain trade body represents nearly 2,000 British manufacturers across all industries, including metal manufacturing, processing, and recycling.
