We’ll look at migration strategies for this new technology, backed by the experience of vendors actively developing solutions with the CLPA. I’ve also been personally involved in the development of edge level and fog computing applications that will harness TSN.

“There’s real value in getting organizations together to discuss their respective technologies. With convergence in mind, it’s important we collaborate on TSN technology. We’re looking forward to meeting and networking with other experts in the field.”
